

## 15 Things to do in or near downtown Portland

- **Pioneer Square and Pioneer Place** — visit Portland’s downtown “living room” on SW Broadway between SW Morrison and SW Yamhill streets and the multi-story boutique mall across 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue. <https://thesquarepdx.org/>
- **Portland Art Museum** — check out current and permanent exhibits at 1219 SW Park Ave. <https://portlandartmuseum.org/>
- **Oregon Historical Society Museum** — learn about Oregon’s history since the mid-1800s at 1200 SW Park Ave. <http://ohs.org/museum/>
- **Portland Farmers Market** — find delicious raw and prepared foods at SW Park and SW Montgomery streets Saturdays from 8:30 a.m. to 2 p.m. <http://www.portlandfarmersmarket.org/>
- **Portland Saturday Market** — explore the local arts and crafts scene at 2 SW Naito Parkway Saturday from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. and Sunday from 11 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. <http://www.portlandsaturdaymarket.com/>
- **Downtown food carts** — choose a quick and delicious meal from dozens of ethnic food carts between SW Alder and SW Washington streets and 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> avenues. <http://www.foodcartspdx.com/maps/>
- **Waterfront Park** — stroll along the Willamette River between the Steel and Tilikum bridges, or do the entire loop (both sides of the river) on foot or by renting an orange City Bike. <https://www.biketownpdx.com/rides/waterfront-park>

- **OHS tram** — take the tram from 3303 SW Bond Ave. on the south waterfront to Oregon Health & Science University for a great view of the city. <http://www.gobytram.com/>

- **Lan Su Chinese Garden** — immerse yourself in a peaceful, classical Chinese garden at 239 NW Everett St. <https://www.lansugarden.org/>
